This is why the company has continued to expand its workforce. In 2022 and 2023, the group increased its staff by nearly 100 new employees. The company also made substantial investments in its own development last year. For 2024, the Vecoplan Group plans to invest another 13 million euros. A significant portion of this will go towards expanding capacity at the production site at its headquarters in Bad Marienberg, Westerwald.
