Recycling: Vecoplan to present its know-how and latest solutions in September

Plastics recycling will also be the main topic at the Plastics Recycling World Expo in Essen (Germany) from 29 to 30 September. At Vecoplan's stand B276, under the banner "Unlimited Plastics Shredding", visitors will learn about its highly efficient shredders that are able to deal with all kinds of input materials. This versatility is becoming increasingly important because closed cycle waste management puts high demands on recycling systems.
