Focus on processes

On 1 May 2024 Daniel Dittmann was appointed Head of Operations at Vecoplan. However, he is also pleased with the successful restructuring: "In each area we were able to put our own staff members into new leadership roles – this not only demonstrates the quality of our personnel, it also shows that at Vecoplan we give dedicated employees a chance to develop and advance in their careers."
